



Camper Packing List

- Bible, journal and pen (Note: WiFi connection is weak at the camp)
- Bed sheet, pillow, blanket, Sleeping bag to keep warm. Personal Wipes and light Cleaning supplies as the rooms, bed mattresses and tables can be dusty.
- Warm and cool clothes (the weather is unpredictable)
- Flip-flops to take showers, Beach shoes, tennis shoes, sunglasses, hats...
- Bath and hand towels...
- Toiletries
- Phone charger, flashlight...
- Extra drinking water, Reusable water bottle
- Personal medication, ear plugs
- Beach gear if you plan to hit the beach: Swimsuit/wetsuit, sunscreen, beach blankets, hats, shade tents, coolers, boogie boards...
- Bring (if available): picnic/lawn chairs (There might not be enough chairs for joint service).

Camp Policies:
