Ш	Bible, Journal and pen (Note: WiFi connection is weak at the camp)
	Bed sheet, pillow, blanket, Sleeping bag to keep warm. Personal Wipes and light Cleaning
	supplies as the rooms, bed mattresses and tables can be dusty.
	Warm and cool clothes (the weather is unpredictable)
	Flip-flops to take showers, Beach shoes, tennis shoes, sunglasses, hats
	Bath and hand towels
	Toiletries
	Phone charger, flashlight
	Extra drinking water, Reusable water bottle
	Personal medication, ear plugs
	Beach gear if you plan to hit the beach: Swimsuit/wetsuit, sunscreen, beach blankets,
	hats, shade tents, coolers, boogie boards
	Bring (if available): picnic/lawn chairs (There might not be enough chairs for joint
	service).
